Class Description:

Logical thinking is an art form in of itself, and a very powerful and applicable one at that. Within this class, there will be a large variety of subjects and applications related to logic. We will learn and discuss mathematical and informational relations (see note), aspects of critical thinking, life applications of logic, philosophical aspects, historical viewpoints, organization/leadership structure, proper questioning and understanding, discussion/debate (only a little, the rest being next semester in the argument class), etc. with any extra time being focused on aspects of logic that the students of the class wish to dive into.

Note: Although mathematics and informational relations will be discussed, have no fear, this is not a math class. Logic is a different branch: think more of Venn diagrams, sets and subsets, A implying B, etc. Having completed or currently being in at least pre-algebra would be ideal, however, only a basic understanding of math is needed.
