5. *Silas Marner* by George Eliot
6. *The Call of the Wild* by Jack London

Class Description:

Students will read six classic works of literature. The initial book list is below, but I will discuss this list with the class to determine if any changes need to be made. We will make changes if the class is particularly enthusiastic about a book or books not on the list. Students should have a copy of *Animal Farm* on the first day of class. We will discuss each book in class. Students must write a one-page response paper related to each book. There may be other assignments and take-home tests.

Grading: Grading will be based on the quality of the one-page papers. Papers will be graded for proper English grammar, punctuation, and usage. There will be a rewrite policy to improve scores.
